Year 5 Trip to Canterbury Cathedral – Thursday 4th November 2021

On Thursday 4th November, both Tiger and Lion classes will be travelling to Canterbury Cathedral to share our collaboration with the Glyndebourne Chorus. This will mark the end of a terms worth of work, where children have been learning how to create original music and perform with confidence.

On the day, children should arrive in school as normal. They will leave shortly after registration and will be travelling by coach to Canterbury Cathedral to perform. Following that, they will walk to the Marlowe Theatre to have lunch, before getting an exclusive first look at the Glyndebourne Chorus' show in the main theatre during the afternoon.

The children are not expected to return to Pilgrims' Way School until 3.40pm. This will mean that all children will need collecting from school, including those who have previously been given permission to walk home. This is due to the much darker evenings that will have set in after half term.

On the day, children will need:

- Full school uniform including sensible shoes and a warm coat.
- A bottle of water.
- A packed lunch from home - if your child qualifies for Free School Meals and you would like the school to provide a packed lunch for your child, please let Mr Hillier (Tiger Class) or Miss Hillary (Lion Class) know via Class Dojo before 3pm on Thursday 21st October 2021.

There is no cost for the trip but as children are travelling by coach, we will need you to give consent for them to go. To do this, please login to Pupil Asset.
