White Cliffs Countryside Partnership at Samphire Hoe – Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022

This term Hummingbird and Kingfisher classes are learning about how and why our local area is changing. To support their learning we are pleased to have booked a trip for them to visit Samphire Hoe Nature Reserve in Dover on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

Samphire Hoe is a country park situated 2 miles west of Dover. The park was created by using 4.9 million cubic metres of chalk marl from the Channel Tunnel excavations and is found at the bottom of a section of the White Cliffs of Dover. The Hoe is an exceptional site for biodiversity and wildlife and we are being given the opportunity to learn about how it was created as well as discovering interesting facts about soils and rocks, supporting the children's learning from our previous terms science topic.

The children should be dropped to school as normal as they will be travelling to the Samphire Hoe by coach just after registration. They will return to school in time for the normal collection time of 3:00 pm.

On the day, children will need:

- Full school uniform.
- Sensible shoes like trainers or wellies, if it is wet weather.
- A warm waterproof coat.
- Warm hat and gloves, as it is very windy near the sea.
- A bottle of water.
- A packed lunch from home (if your child qualifies for free school meals and you would like us to provide a packed lunch from school, please let your child's class teacher know by Class Dojo).

We are asking for a contribution of £10 per child for this trip.
