Dear Parents/Carers of Year 4 Children

Trip to the Viking Ship and Turner Contemporary Art Gallery on Thursday 21st April 2022

We are writing to inform you of a trip for Woodpecker and Eagle Classes that we are planning for the first week of Term 5, on Thursday, 21st April 2022.

We are planning to take the children on a double trip, first to Pegwell Bay in Ramsgate to visit the Viking Ship there and then on to Turner Contemporary art gallery in Margate to see some of the interesting artworks on display. We will eat a picnic lunch on the beach before returning to school for 3pm.

Both of these places are significant to our learning in Year 4, as we have studied the Vikings (Term 3) and learnt about the historical significance of the replica Viking Ship in Pegwell Bay. We have also tried various types of art this year so will benefit from seeing professional artworks on display.

The children should be dropped to school as normal as they will be travelling to Pegwell Bay by coach just after registration. They will return to school in time for the normal collection time of 3:00 pm.

On the day, children will need:

- Full school uniform.
- Sensible shoes like trainers or wellies, if it is wet weather.
- A warm waterproof coat.
- Warm hat and gloves, as it can be very windy near the sea.
- A bottle of water.
- A packed lunch from home (if your child qualifies for free school meals and you would like us to provide a packed lunch from school, please let your child's class teacher know by Class Dojo).

The cost of this trip is £8.00, to cover the cost of the coach that will take us on our journey.
