Botany Bay- Monday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2022

We are pleased to have booked a trip to visit Botany Bay beach in Broadstairs on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> July.

Botany Bay beach offers the children the opportunity to observe different natural features in the environment, from rock pools and fossils, to the white chalk cliffs. This trip offers the children the opportunity to reflect on some of their previous topics throughout the year. The children have previously studied rocks and soils in science, which they can use when fossil hunting in the sand. It also offers them the chance to compare coastlines following their local environment topic and our previous trip to a manmade, rocky beach.

The children should be dropped to school at 8:40am as they will be travelling to Botany Bay by double-decker coach at 9:00am. They will return to school in time for the normal collection time of 3:00 pm.

On the day, children will need:

- Full school uniform.
- Sensible shoes, like trainers.
- Sun cream and sun hat.
- A bottle of water.

The children will be having a portion of chips and an ice cream on the beach. However, if you would prefer your child to have a packed lunch please bring one from home or if your child qualifies for free school meals and you would like us to provide a packed lunch from school, please let your child's class teacher know by Class Dojo.
