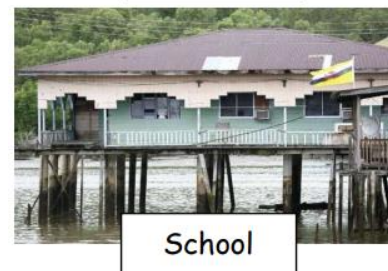
Kampong Ayer is in the continent of Asia, located in the small country of Brunei, which is situated on the island of Borneo.









Kampong Ayer and Brunei have a tropical climate because of their location close to the equator and tropical rainforest is the dominant vegetation
