## Dear Parent/Carers of Hornbill Class

We are so excited to be able to offer Hornbill Class a trip to Nonnington Farm on Thursday 22nd June 2023. This trip is being organised and funded by Warburtons and Country Trust. The Country Trust Farm Discovery Programme offers visits to real working farms to schools bringing children a unique opportunity to experience the working countryside first hand. The itinerary of the trip centres around seed to loaf so the children will start the day off exploring the soil and finish off looking at how wheat becomes flour.

The children will be traveling to the farm by coach, leaving school just after registration and arriving back in time for normal collection at 3pm.

On the day the children will need to be dressed appropriately for the trip. Children need to wear school polo shirt and jumper but will need tracksuit bottoms, trousers or leggings (skirts are not suitable, and jeans are very uncomfortable if they get wet). They will also need to wear sturdy trainers, walking boots or wellies.

Of course, the weather can be very unpredictable so you will need to provide suitable items for the day e.g. raincoat, hat, sun cream, water bottle. Children will need to be able to carry these with them so a backpack will be required.

There is no charge for this trip but you will need to give consent for your child to travel by coach. Please logon to your child's ParentPay account by 26<sup>th</sup> May to give this consent.
