Year 5 Imperial War Museum Trip

Starting in Term 2, the topic for Year 5 will be Conflict, Creativity and Unity. Our focus will be on World War 1 and the innovations, creativity and cultural change that resulted from it, both in Britain and across the world. To help engage the children and provide first-hand experience, the Year 5 classes we will be taking a trip to London to visit the Imperial War Museum, to explore the exhibits and exhibitions. This visit will help to expand the children's knowledge on the topic, as well as be a focal point for the learning that will be carried out throughout the term.

The date of the trip will Monday 4th November 2019. The coach will be departing from school at 8:45am. We are asking the children to arrive no later than **8:30am** to ensure a quick and timely departure. We will arrive at the museum in London by 10:30am where the children will have the opportunity to explore and learn about the topic. The coach will be leaving London at 2:30pm and we expect to return to school at **4:30pm**. In case of a delay in leaving London, the trip leader will inform the school, who will in turn inform the parents.

The cost of this exciting educational trip is £13 per child which can be paid in full or in 2 payments as below. Payment can be made in cash to the school office or via the school gateway app.
