From September, the government is setting new requirements for wrap-around care, so all schools should aim to provide care for children from 8am till 6pm. At present we only offer care till 5:15pm.

We have listened to parents and know that you want to have extended after-school care to support working patterns and/or more options for children to access a club after school even if it comes at a cost.
