Reading Texts	Holes by Louis Sachar Skellig by David Almond
Writing Purposes	This term, we will begin by focusing on writing to inform through a report of a mysterious creature at Pilgrims' Way. This links with our reading of the book 'Skellig'. We will also be writing to entertain with a narrative about our class bird.

 MATHS	
Termly Focus 1: Place Value	- Read and write numbers to 10,000,000 - Place numbers to 10,000,000 on a number line - Compare, order and round integers - Negative numbers
Termly Focus 2: Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division	- Add and subtract integers - Multiply a 4-digit number by a 2-digit number - Long division

 SCIENCE	
Focus:	Energy – Light and Reflection
Key Learning:	Year 6 will explore how light travels, how we see objects and how shadows are formed. They will investigate reflection, mirrors and periscopes, using ray diagrams to explain how light behaves.

 Geography	
Focus:	Where does our energy come from?
Key Learning:	The children will be investigating how natural resources and energy are used in the UK and the USA as well as developing an understanding of global time zones.

 PSHE	
Focus:	Being me in my world
Key Learning:	The children will explore identity, responsibilities and relationships. They will reflect on their role within the school community, set personal goals and consider how their choices and actions can positively influence others.

 RE	
Focus:	Why does religion look different around the world?
Key Learning:	Year 6 will explore similarities and differences between Jewish, Muslim and Christian beliefs. They will learn how beliefs are reflected through religious practices, traditions, symbols and community life.

 ART	
Focus:	Drawing – Expressing Ideas
Key Learning:	The children will be exploring how drawing can be used to express ideas and messages, inspired by a range of street art examples and environmental themes.

 PE	
Focus:	Cricket
Key Learning:	This half term, Year 6 will have cricket lessons delivered by coaches from the cricket ground. They will develop their batting, bowling and fielding skills while learning tactics, teamwork and the rules of cricket.

 Music	
Focus:	Film Music
Key Learning:	Music learning explores how music creates mood and emotion in films. The children will develop their understanding of pitch, tempo and dynamics, create graphic scores and compose and perform music.
